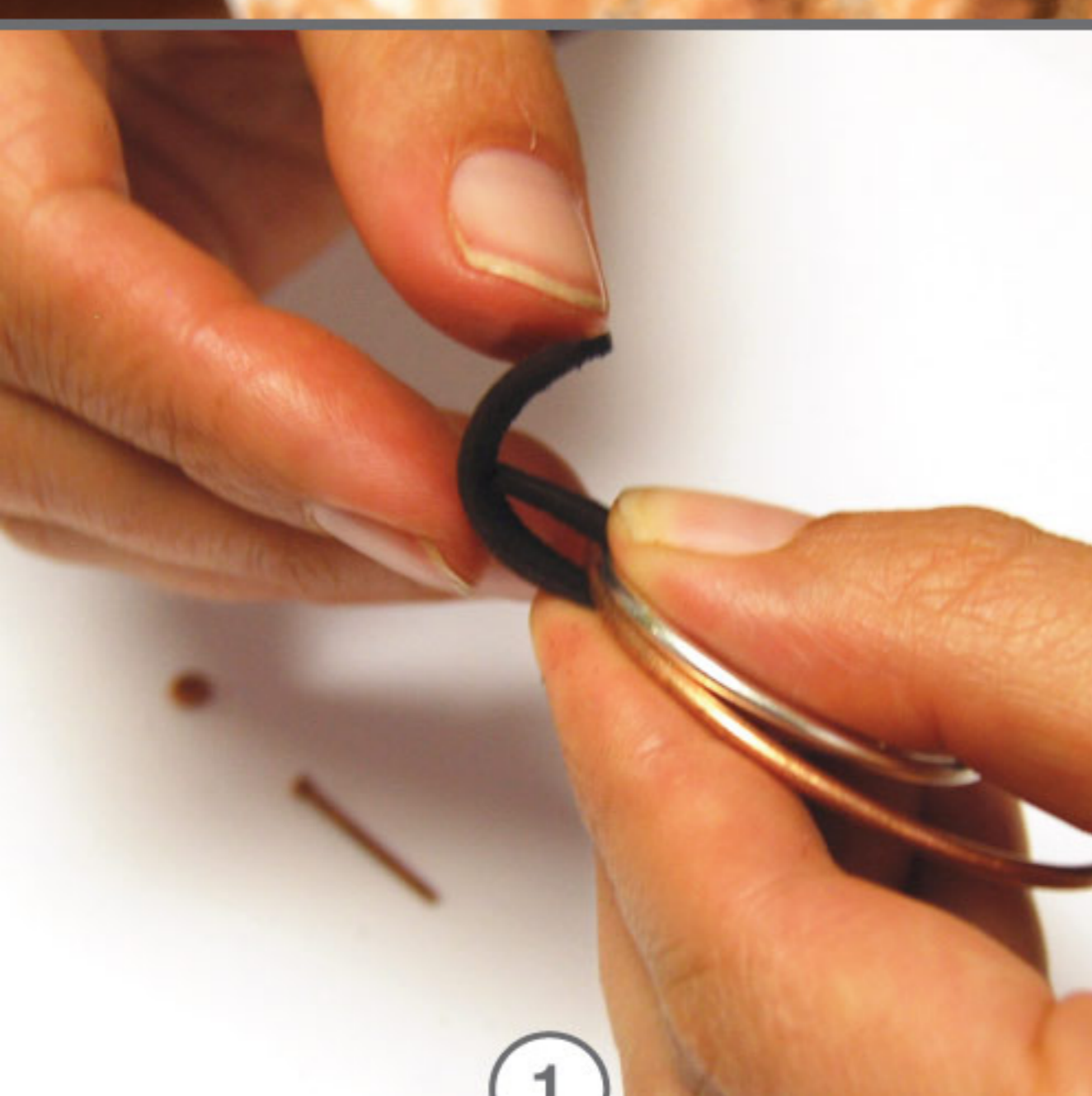


MAKE THIS OPEN FRAME BOHO HOOP NECKLACE WITH LEATHER CONNECTORS



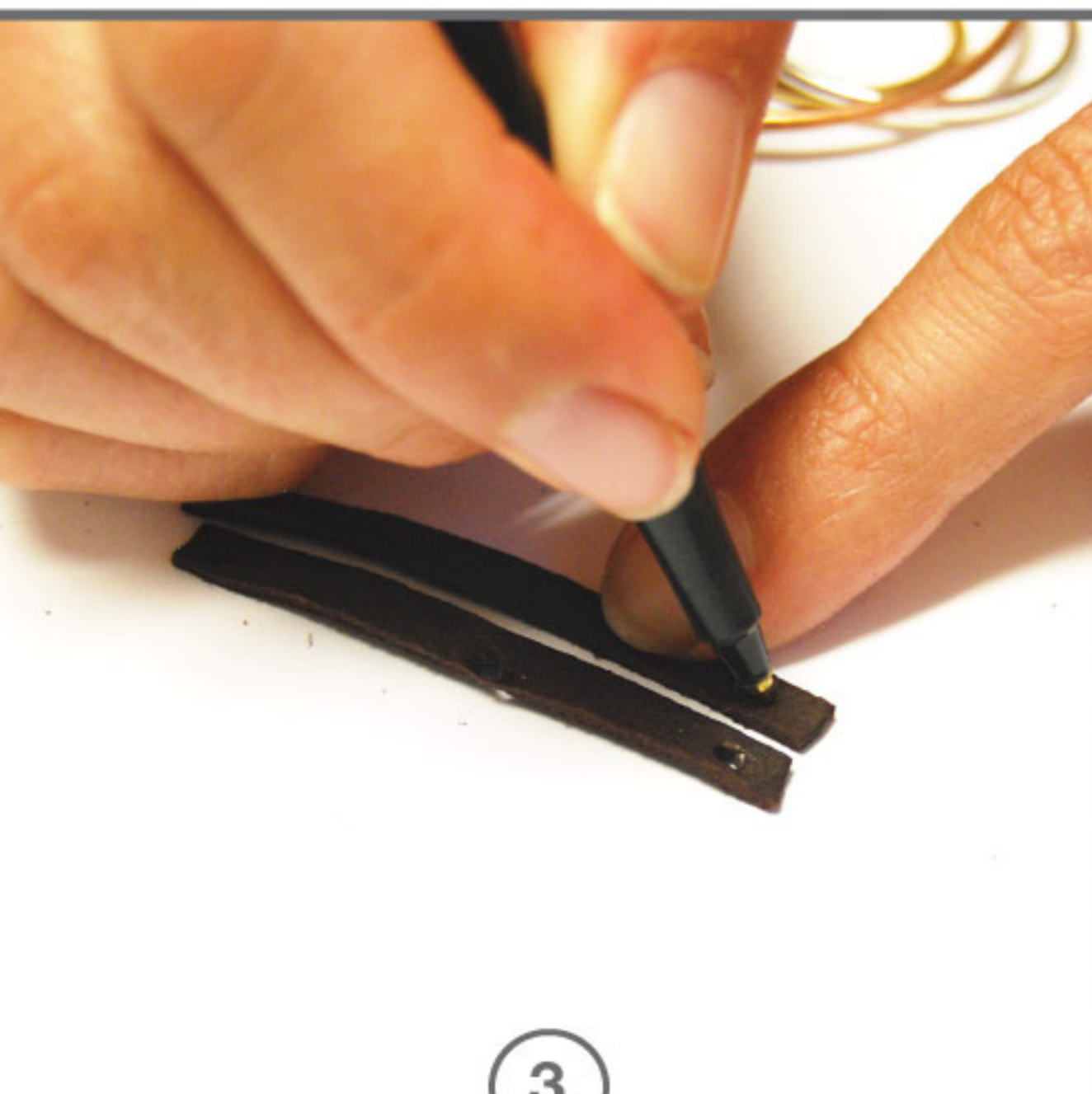

Create a leather template: Cut a 2" strip. Create an overlapping circle around the Open Hoops.



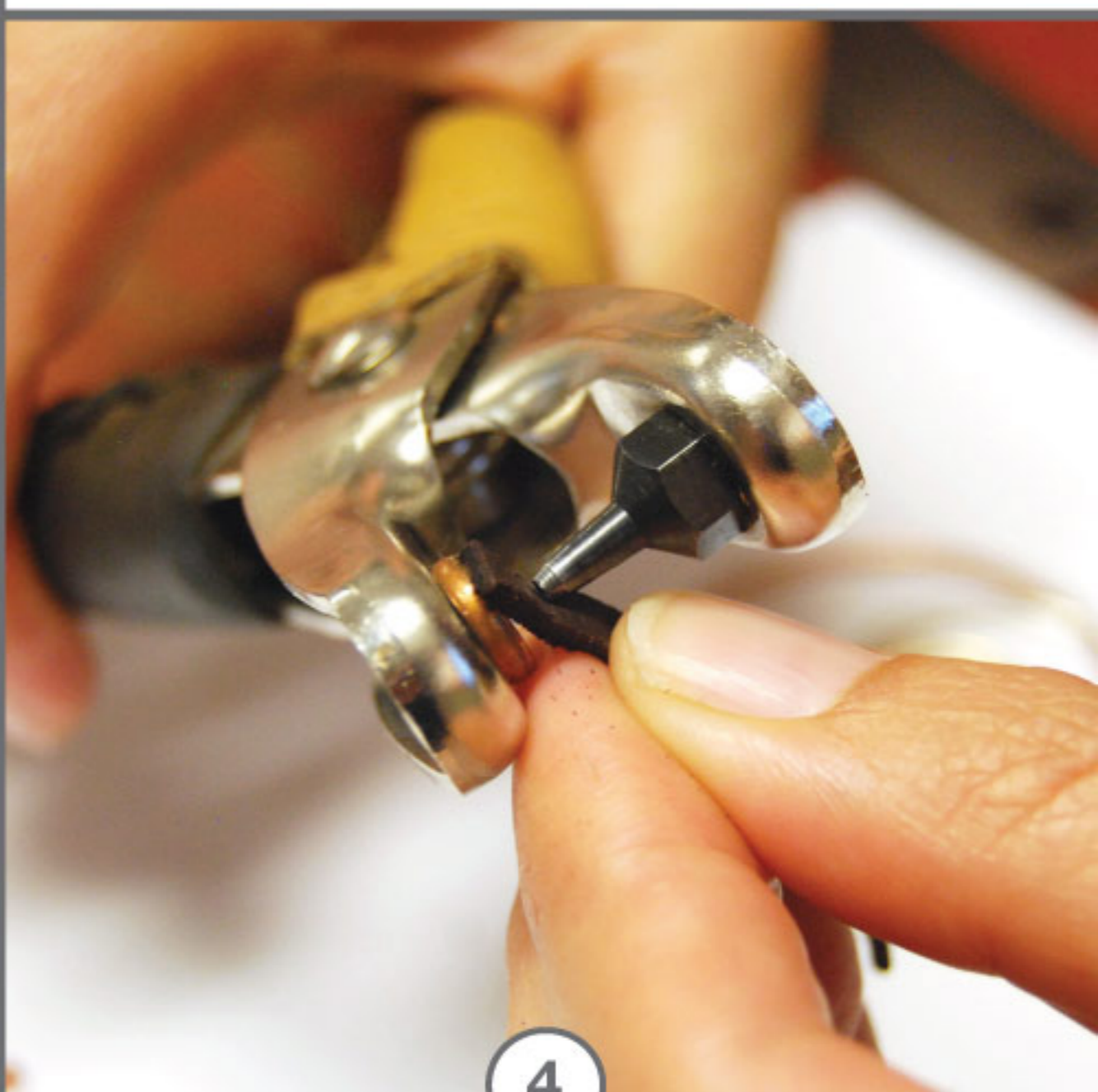

Leave enough room on the top of the leather connector to thread your ballchain at the end. Line up your leather and punch a hole through.



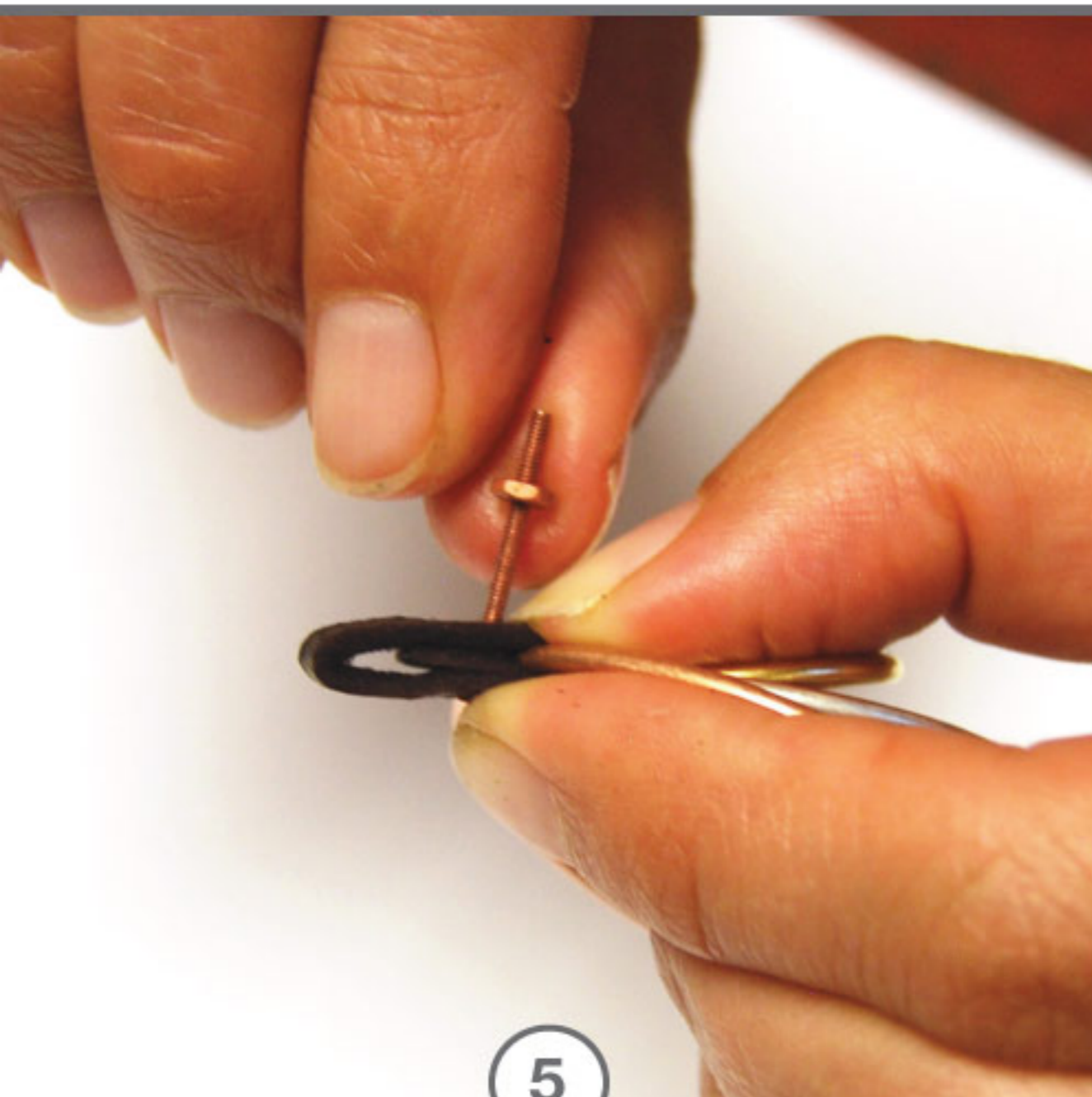

Use the hole punched template as a guide to indicate where to mark the hole placements on the Deerskin Lace with a pen or pencil.



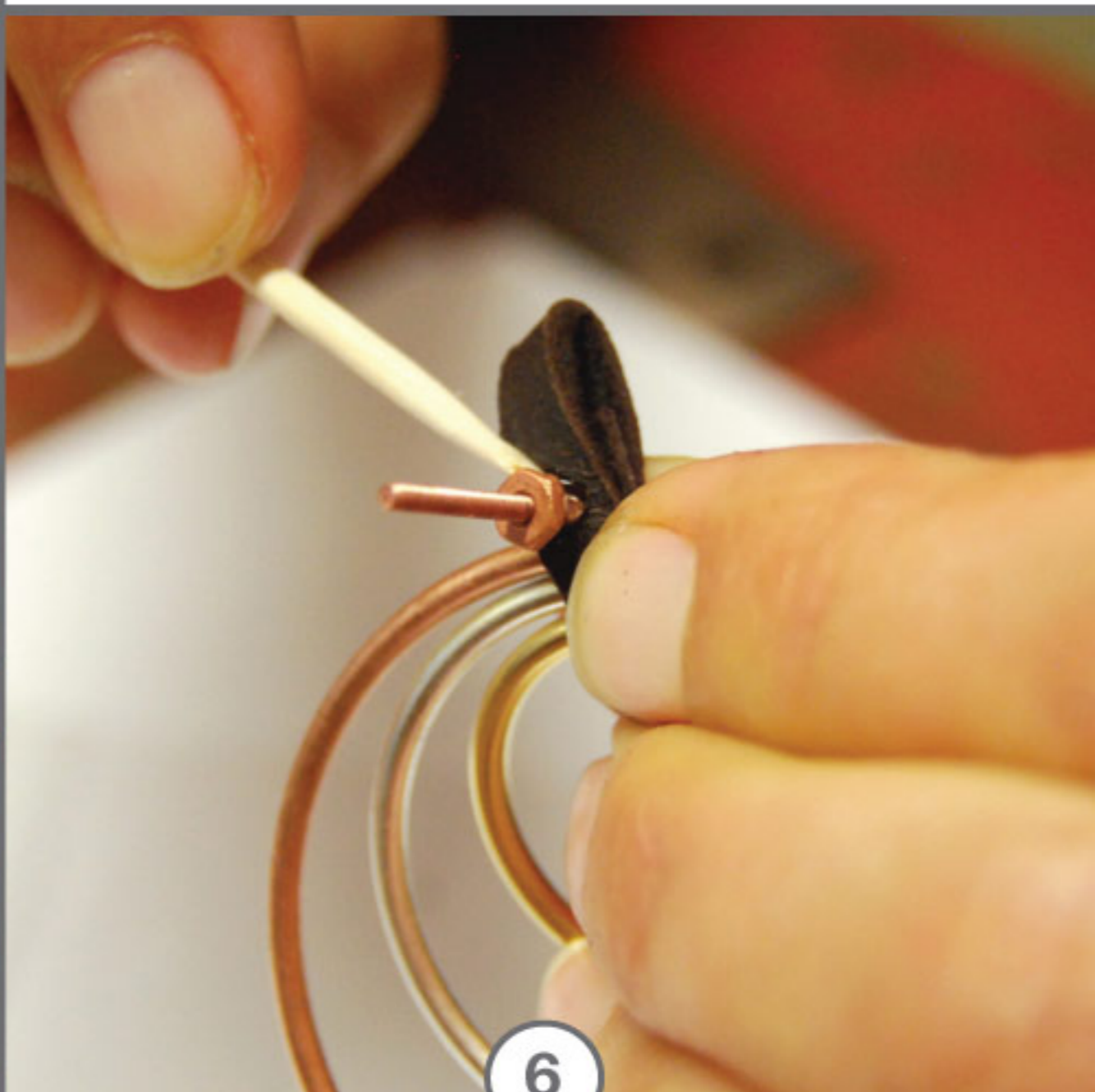

Punch all three holes in the center of the Deerskin Lace in the locations that you have marked.

Wrap Deerskin Lace around Open Frame Hoops. Line up holes and insert micro screw thread on bolt.



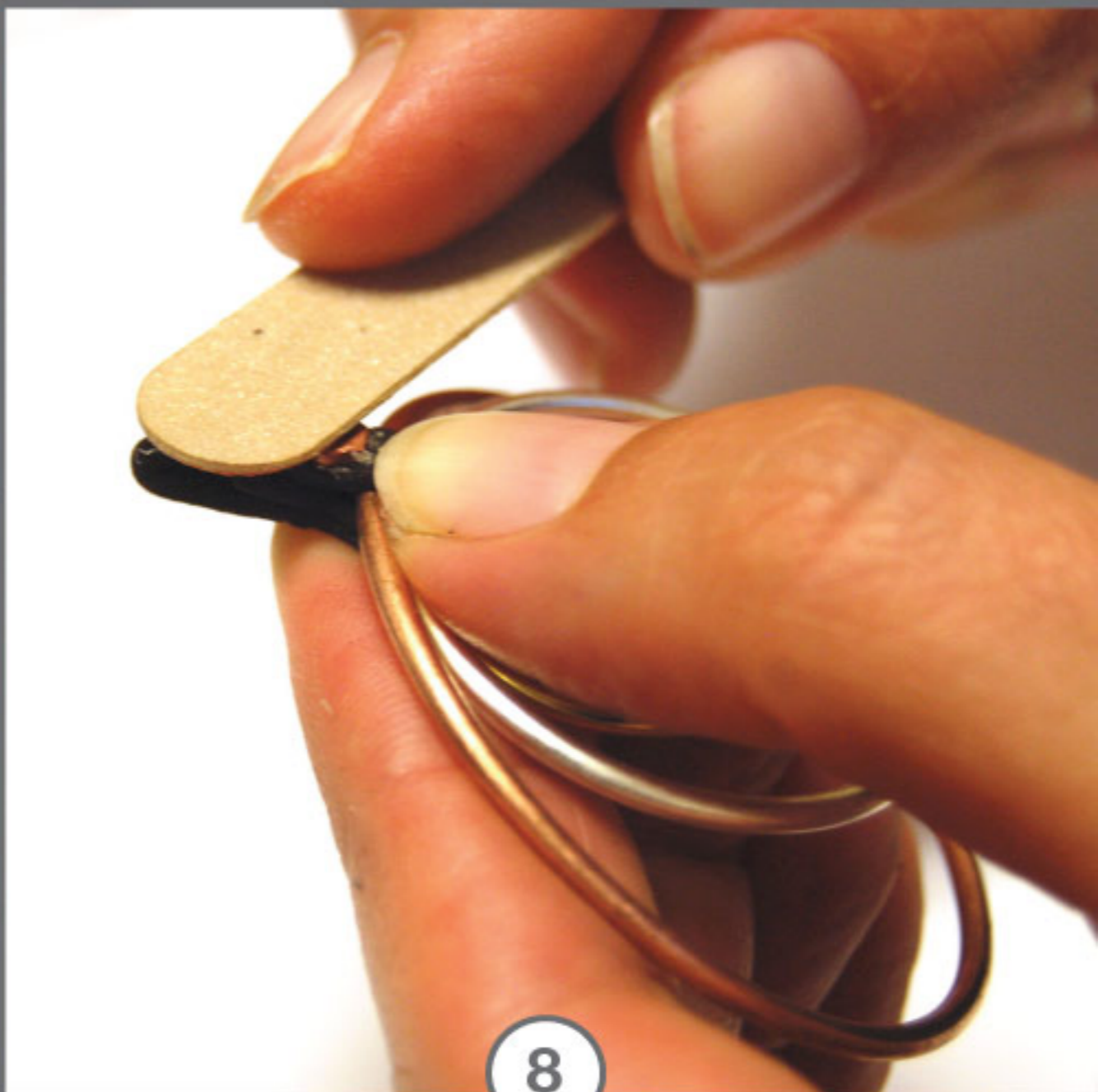

Insert glue such as E6000 or Bond 527 Cement with toothpick under bolt. Tighten bolt all the way down with needle nose pliers.

Use a pair of Flush Cutters to cut away the excess shank. Make sure to hold onto the Micro Screw so that it doesn't go flying off.



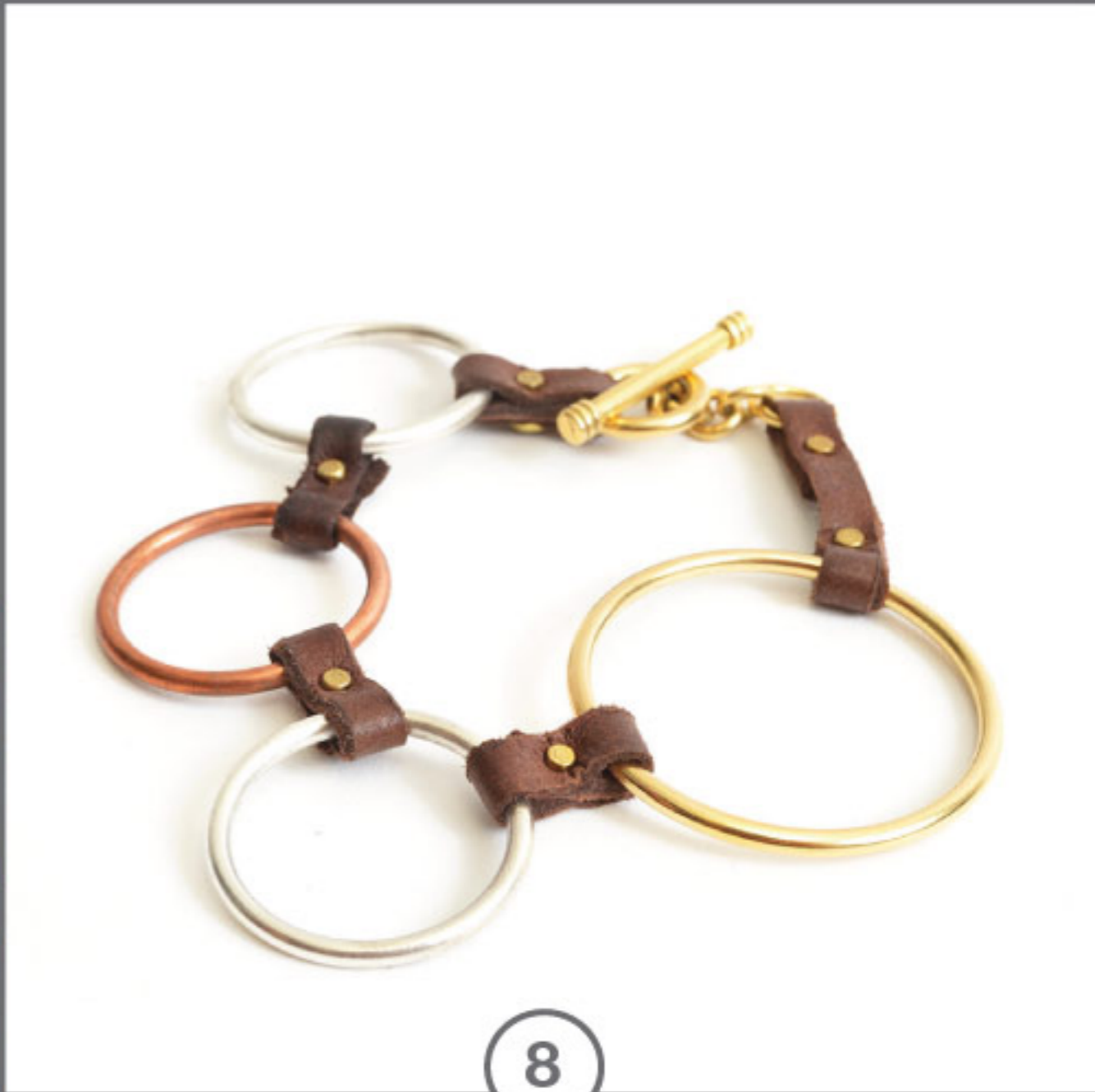

Use a file or an emery board to sand down the cut screw to create a smooth surface.

Cut Ball Chain to desired length and thread the chain through the leather connector created in steps 1-6. Attach Ball Chain Connector.
