

USING EXCESS CRYSTAL CLAY BITS –
CREATE A BEAD!



1

To mix Crystal Clay, pinch off equal sized balls of Part A and B. Blend together until there is no marbling.



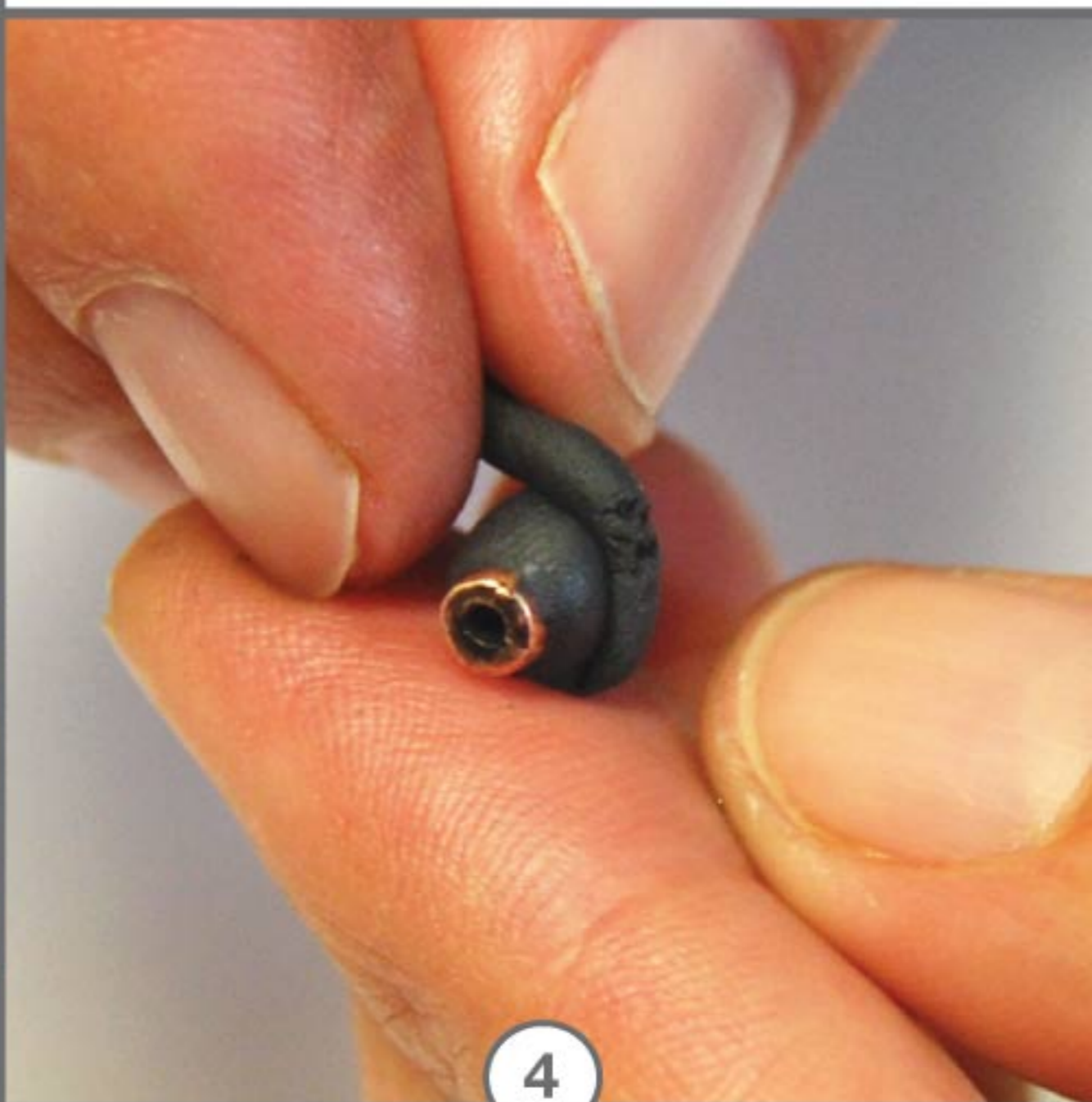

Roll the ball into a small snake about 3/4" long.



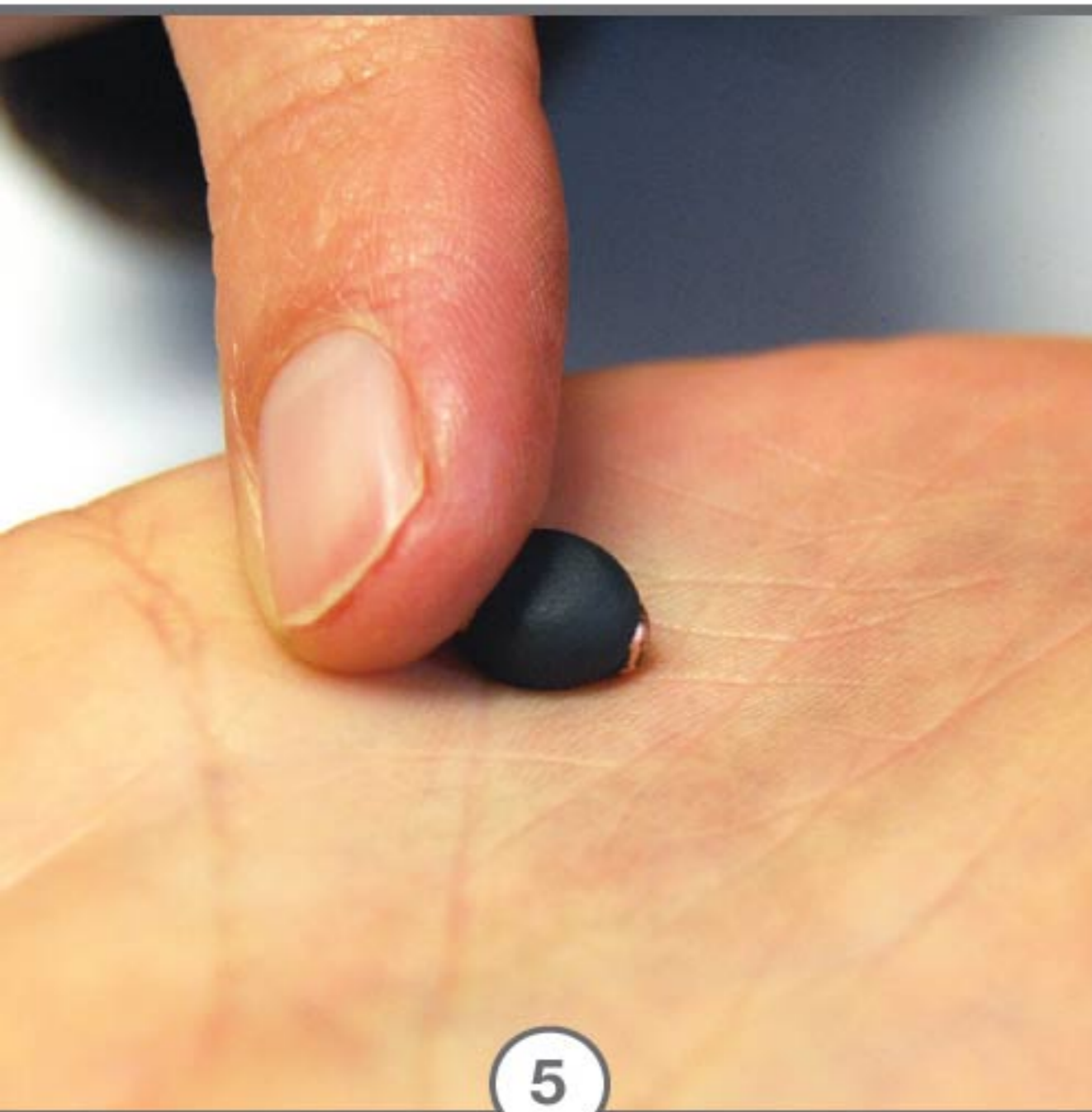

Wrap the snaked Crystal Clay around the center of a tube bead.

Add more clay if needed.



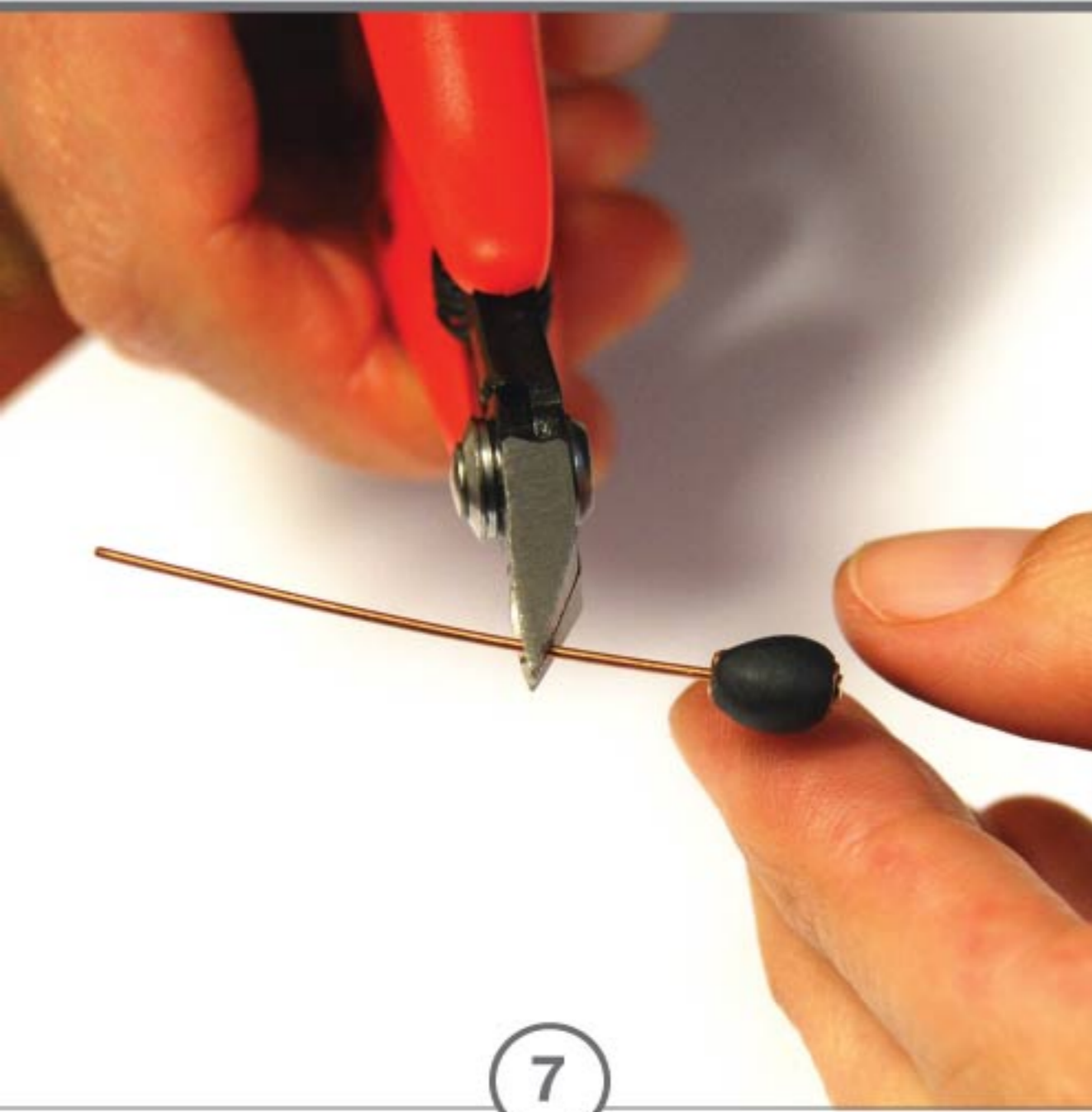

Roll the Crystal Clay wrapped tube bead around in the palm of your hand. As it rolls it will press to the edges of the bead.



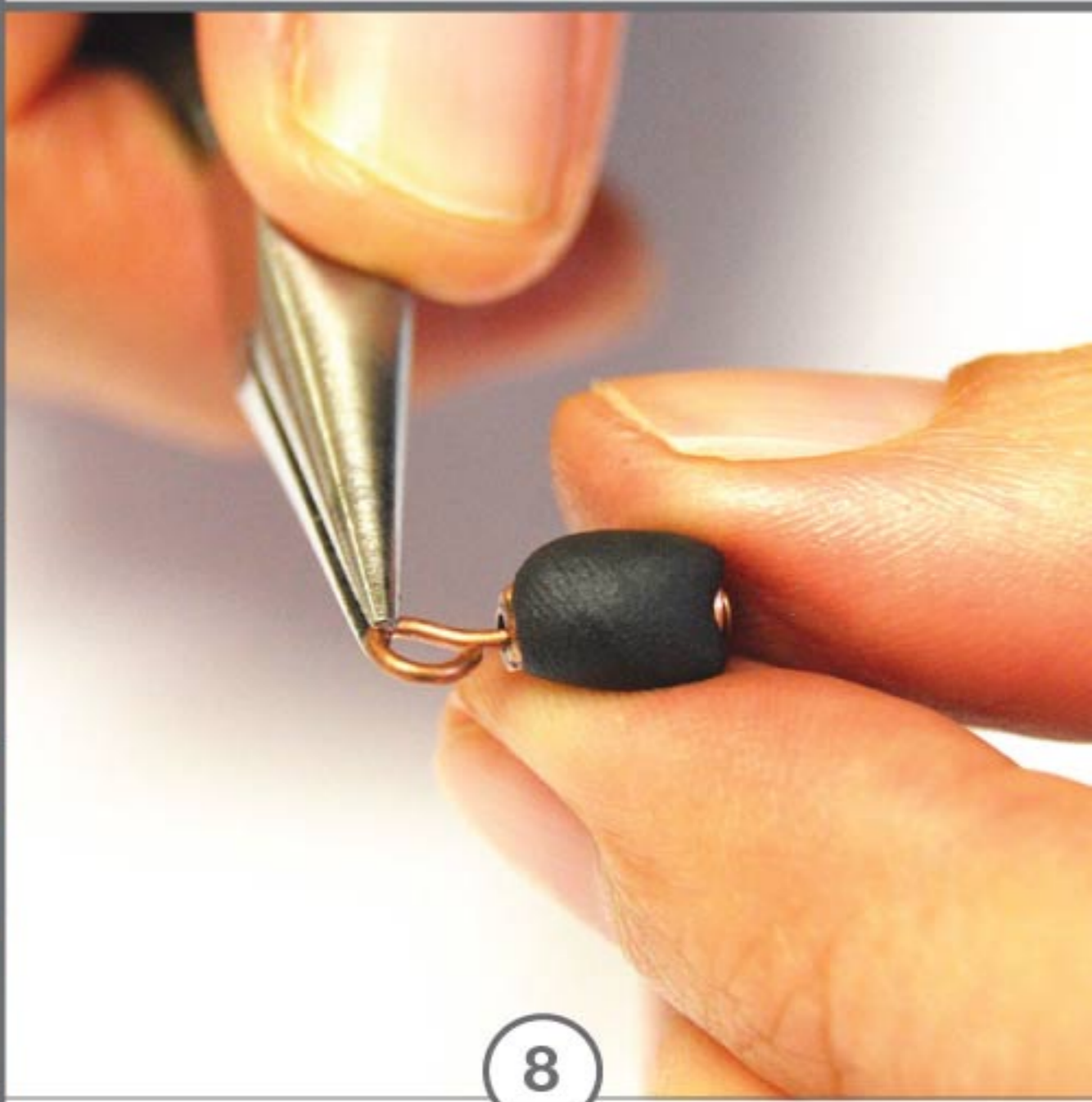

Optional: Gently roll the tube bead across a texturizing pad to create a pattern in the clay. Apply baby powder to the pad beforehand.

Once your bead has cured (12 hours), thread on a headpin. Use flush cutters to cut off the excess.

Create a loop with a pair of needle nose pliers. Viola. Now you are ready to assemble to your project.
