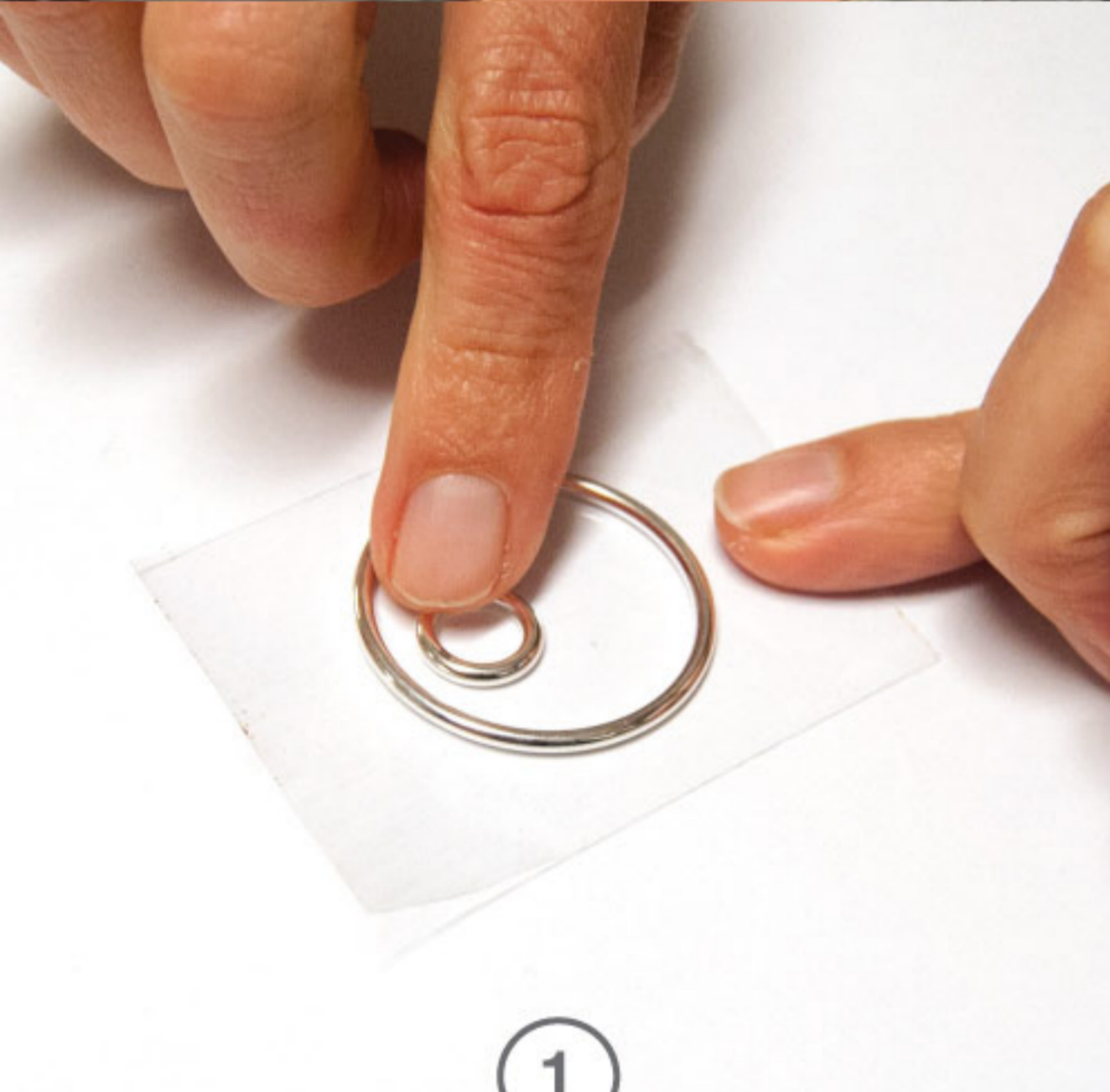
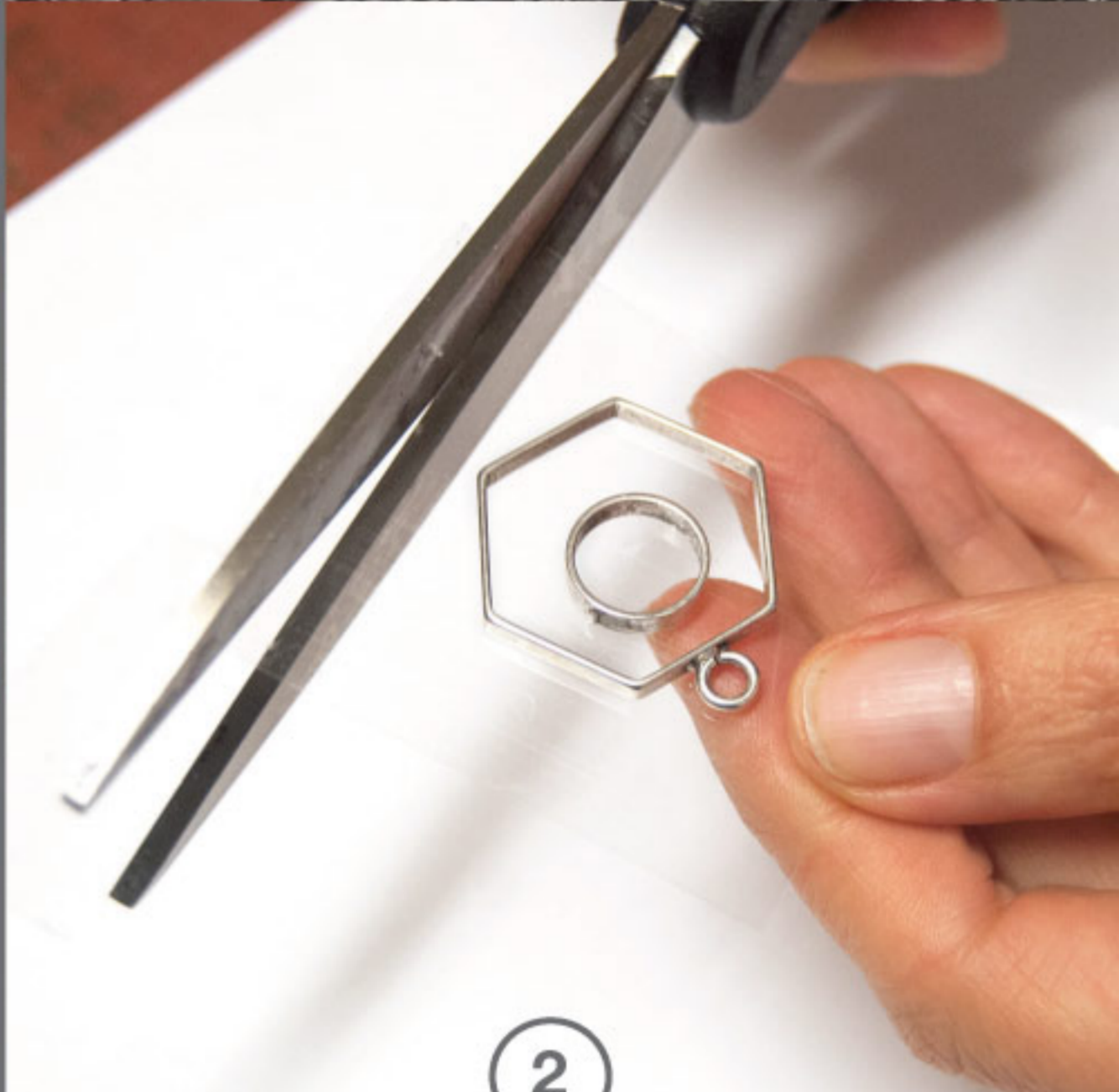


CREATE PENDANTS WITH
COLORIZED RESIN IN OPEN FRAMES

Place an Open Frame on a piece of packing tape. Place a smaller one inside of that one. Press down and burnish bezels to tape.



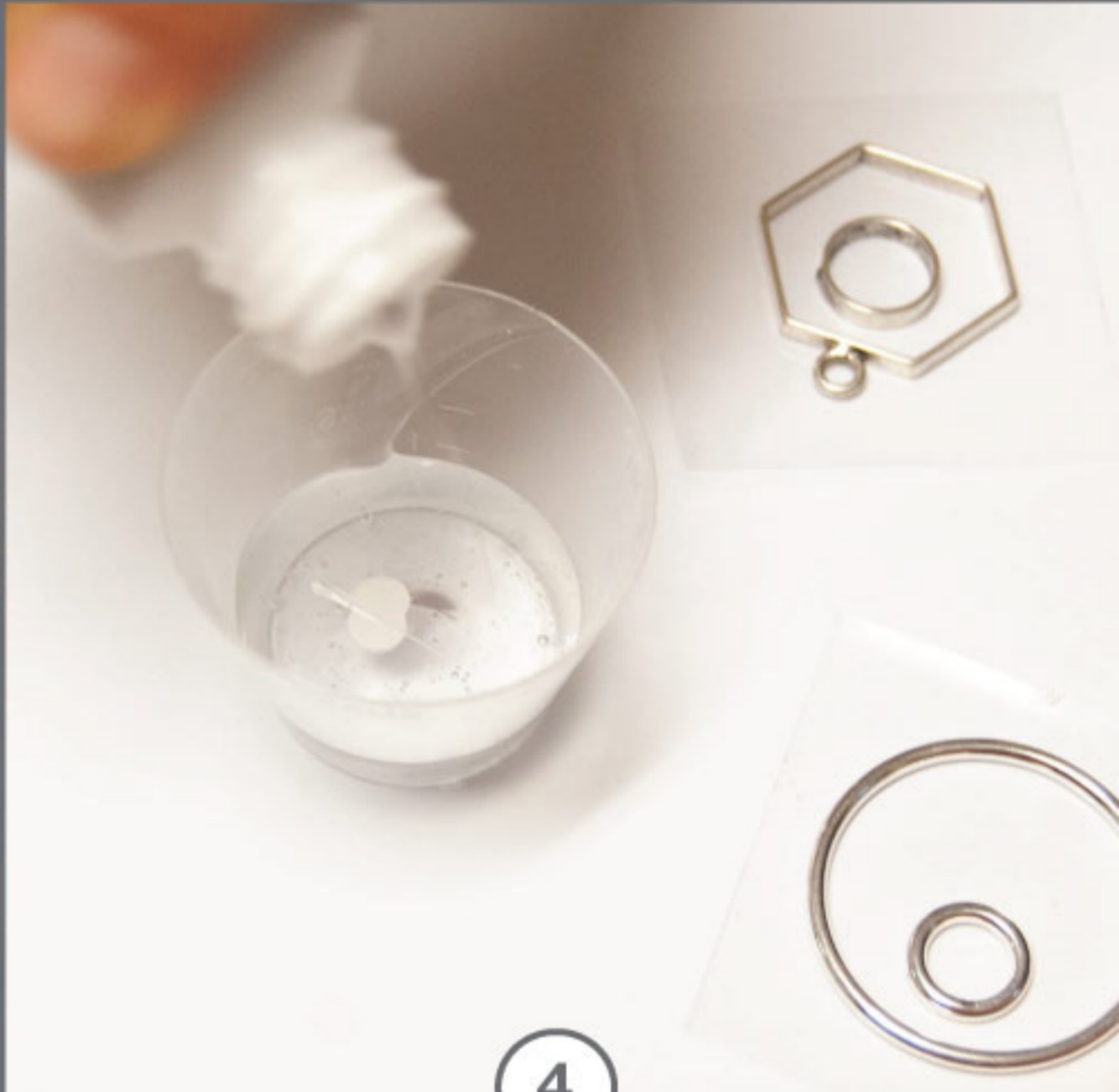

Trim away excess packing tape from around your Open Frame to avoid potentially disturbing the piece when resin is curing.



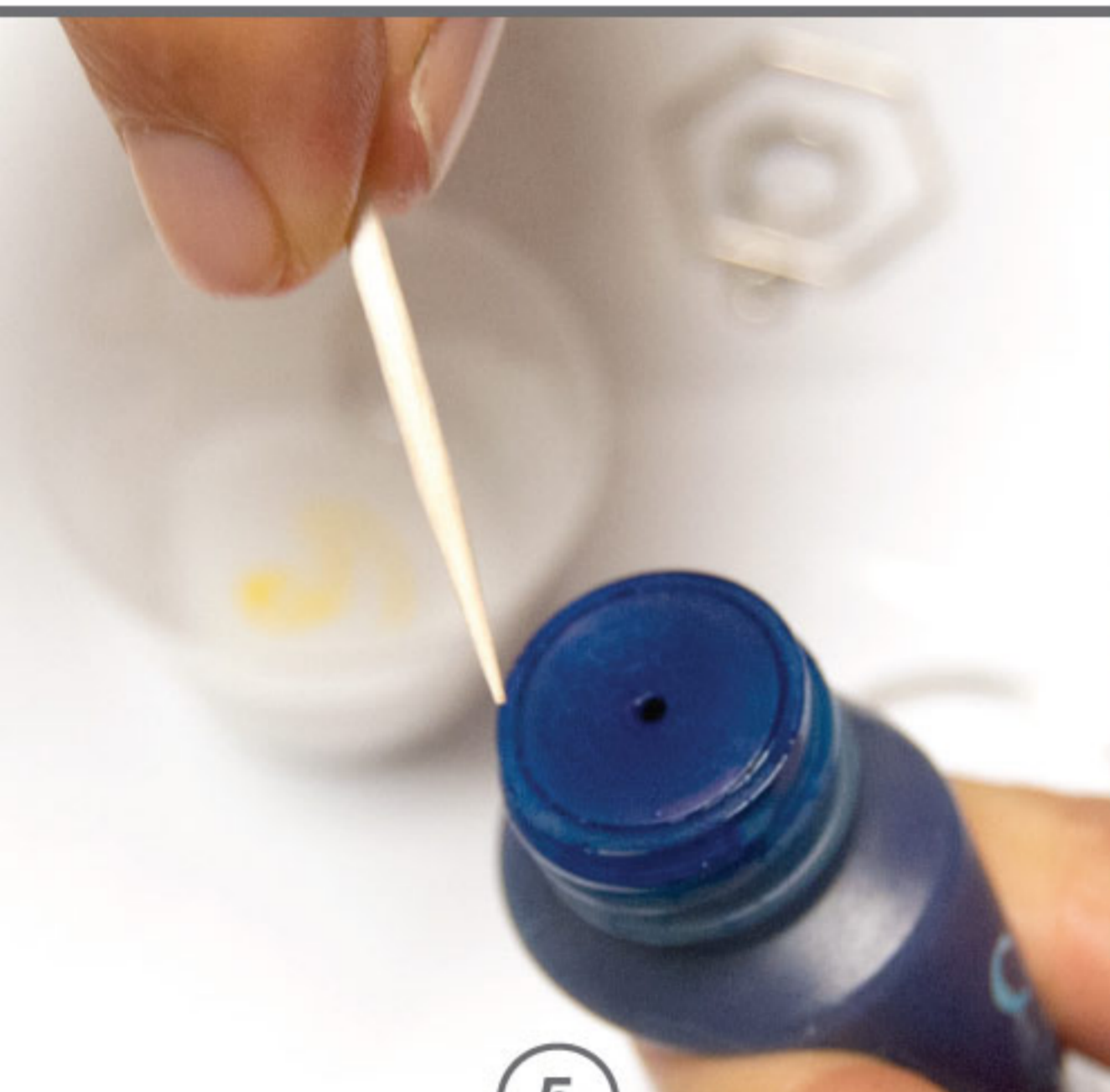

Mix resin: Pour equal parts of A, then B, of Nunn Design 2-Part Resin into cup, mix for 2 minutes and put under lamp for 5 min.



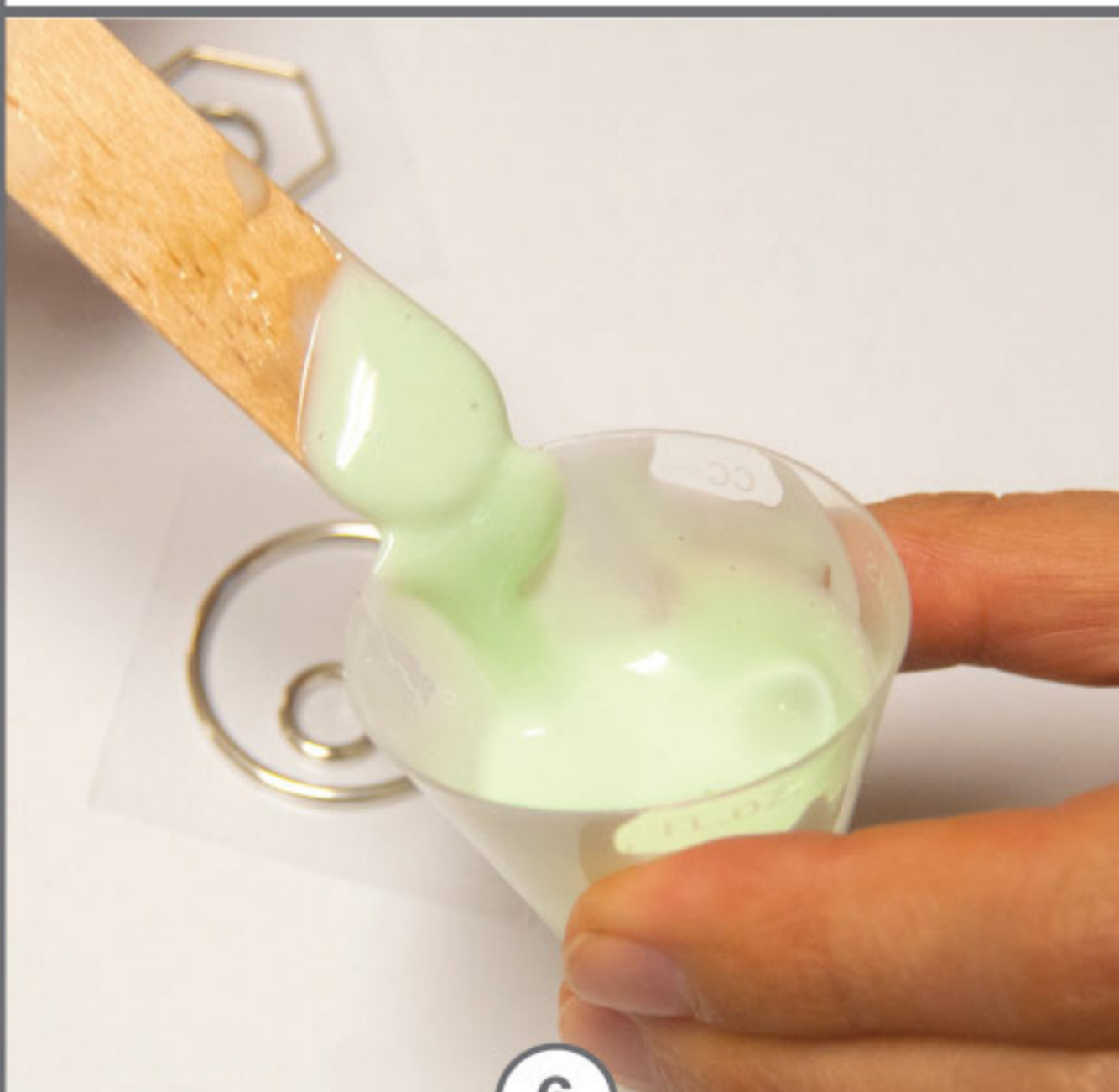

Pour a small amount of mixed resin into a cup. Start with adding Castin' Craft Opaque Pigment White to create an opaque color.

Then add a tiny toothpick tip of Castin' Craft Opaque Pigments Yellow and Blue. (Or your own color preferences.)

Continue mixing the resin until you have the desired color, like this beautiful sea-foam green color.

Slowly drizzle resin into Open Frame until partially full. Use toothpick to agitate and loosen bubbles, continue pouring resin until full.

Once fully cured (up to 72 hours), remove the packing tape from backside. Keep touching tape onto surface until no longer sticky.

Still Sticky? Use Goo Be Gone. Apply a couple drops, let sit for over a minute, use stir stick to scrape off residue. Wash with soap/water.

Use needle nose pliers to add jumpings and chain to your resin pendants. Don't they look awesome!
