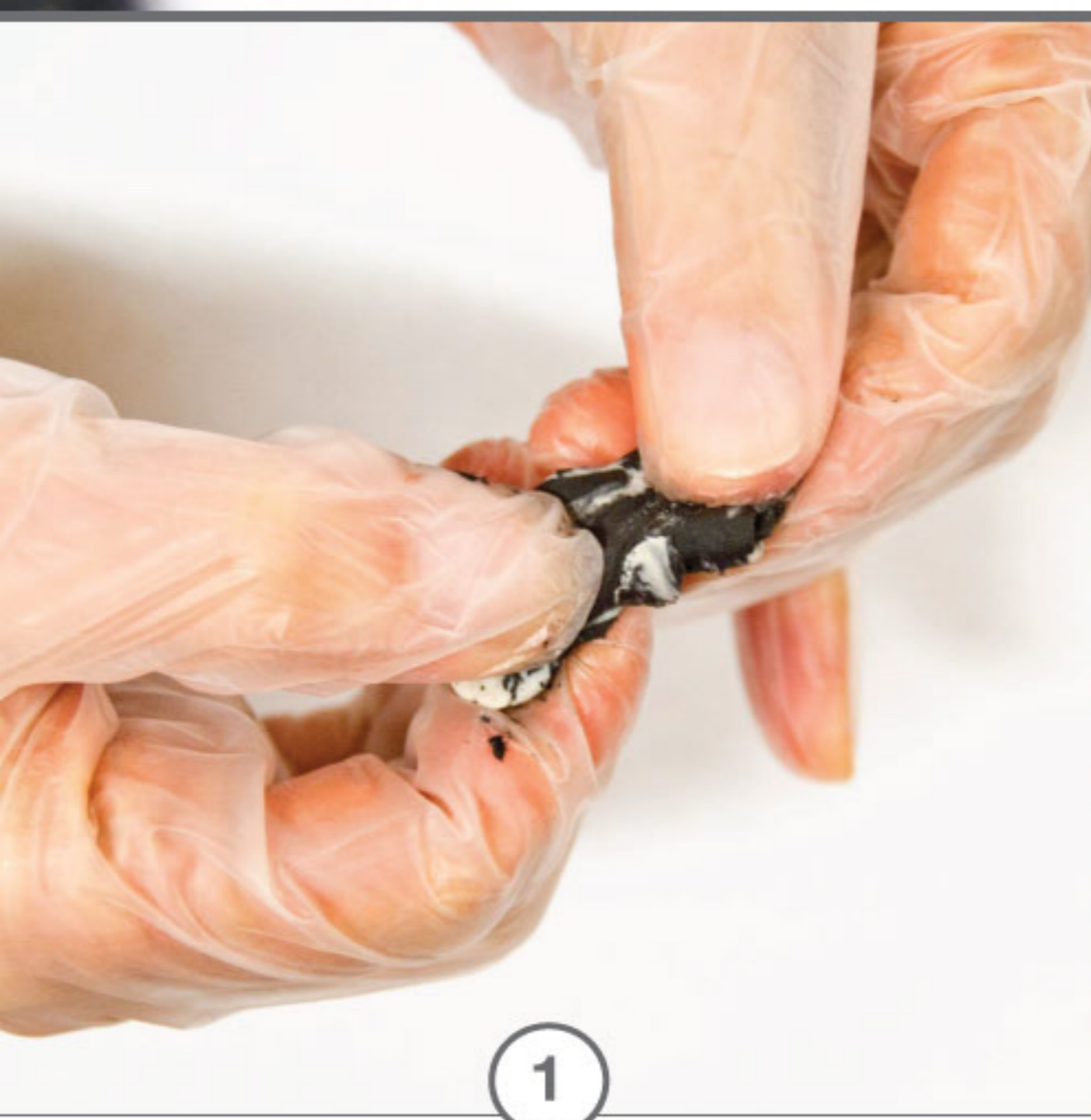
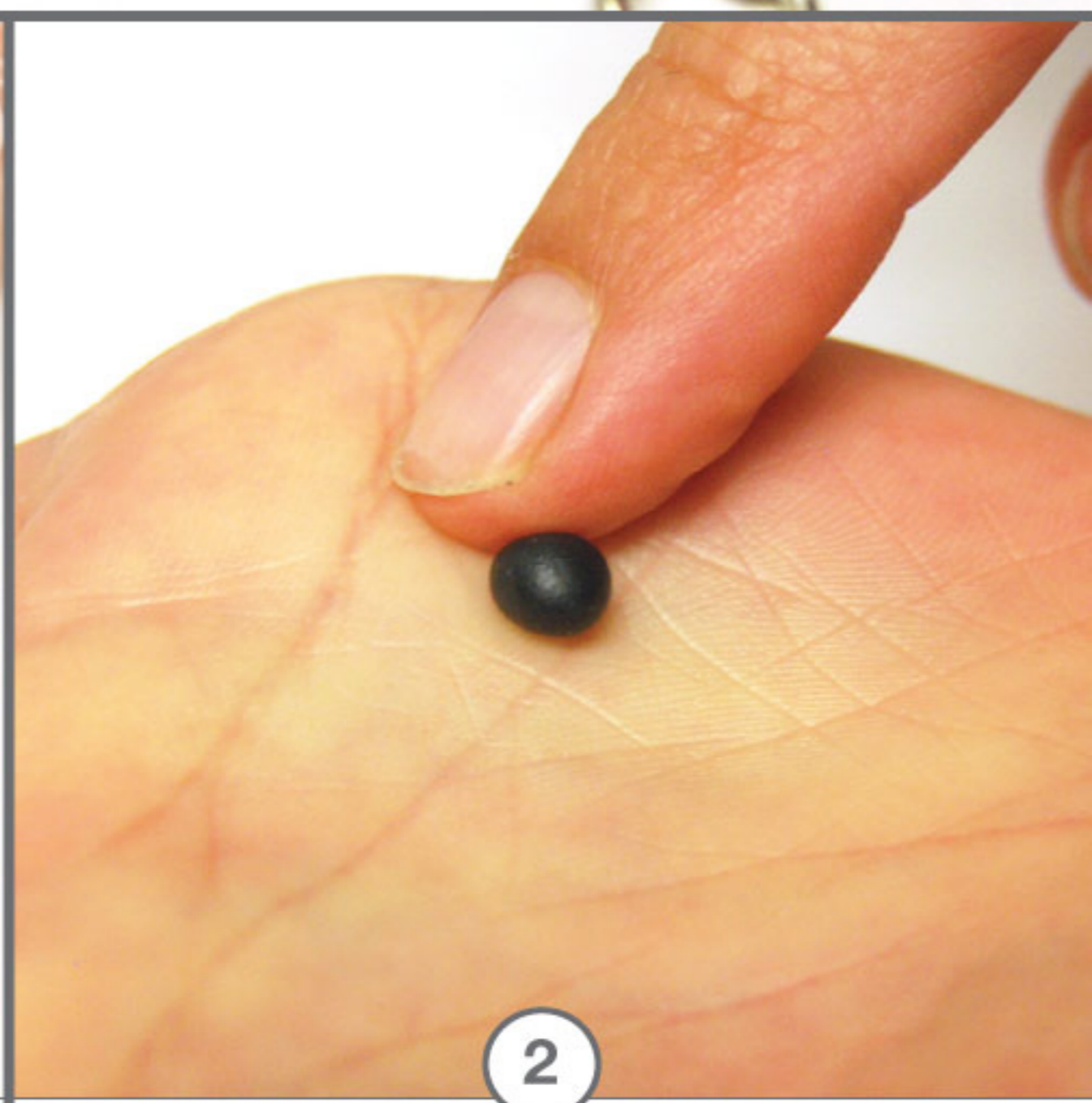


CREATE ACCENTS ON JUMPRINGS WITH EXCESS CRYSTAL CLAY BITS



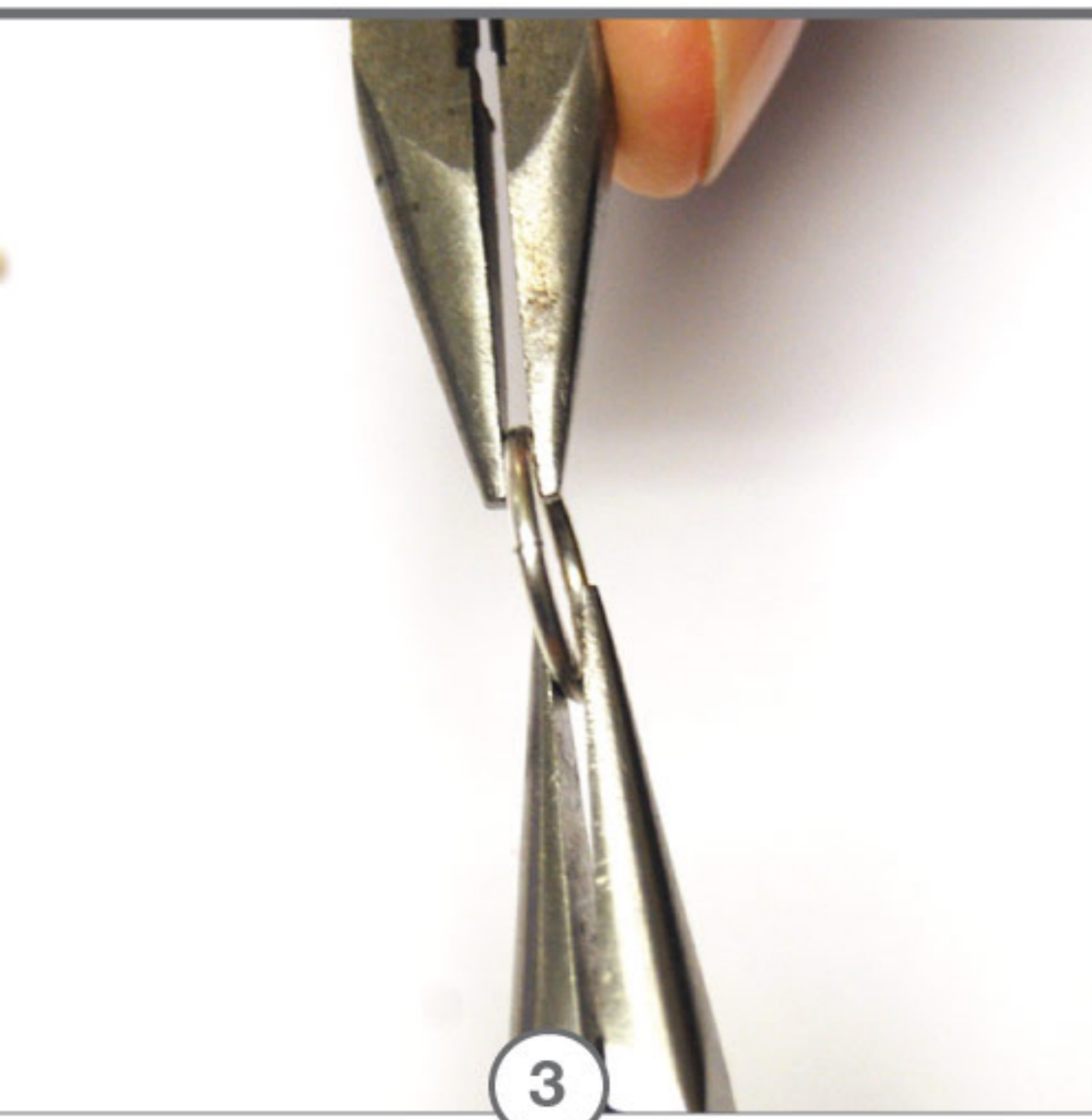

Mix Crystal Clay. Pinch off equal sized balls of Part A and Part B and blend together fully until the clay is no longer marbled.



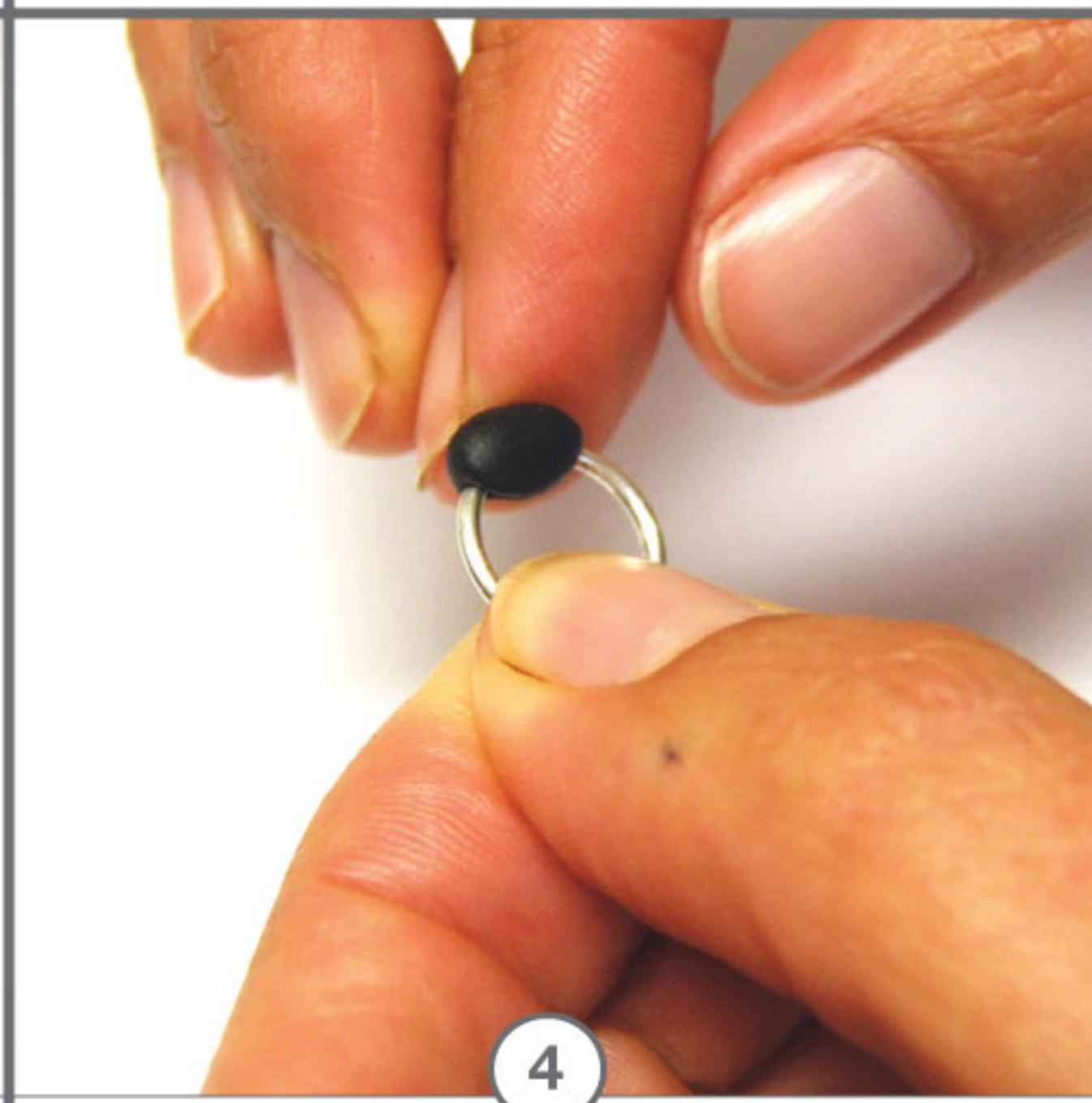

Pinch off a small ball of clay and roll it in your palm until smooth. Creases in the clay may be more challenging to smooth out later.



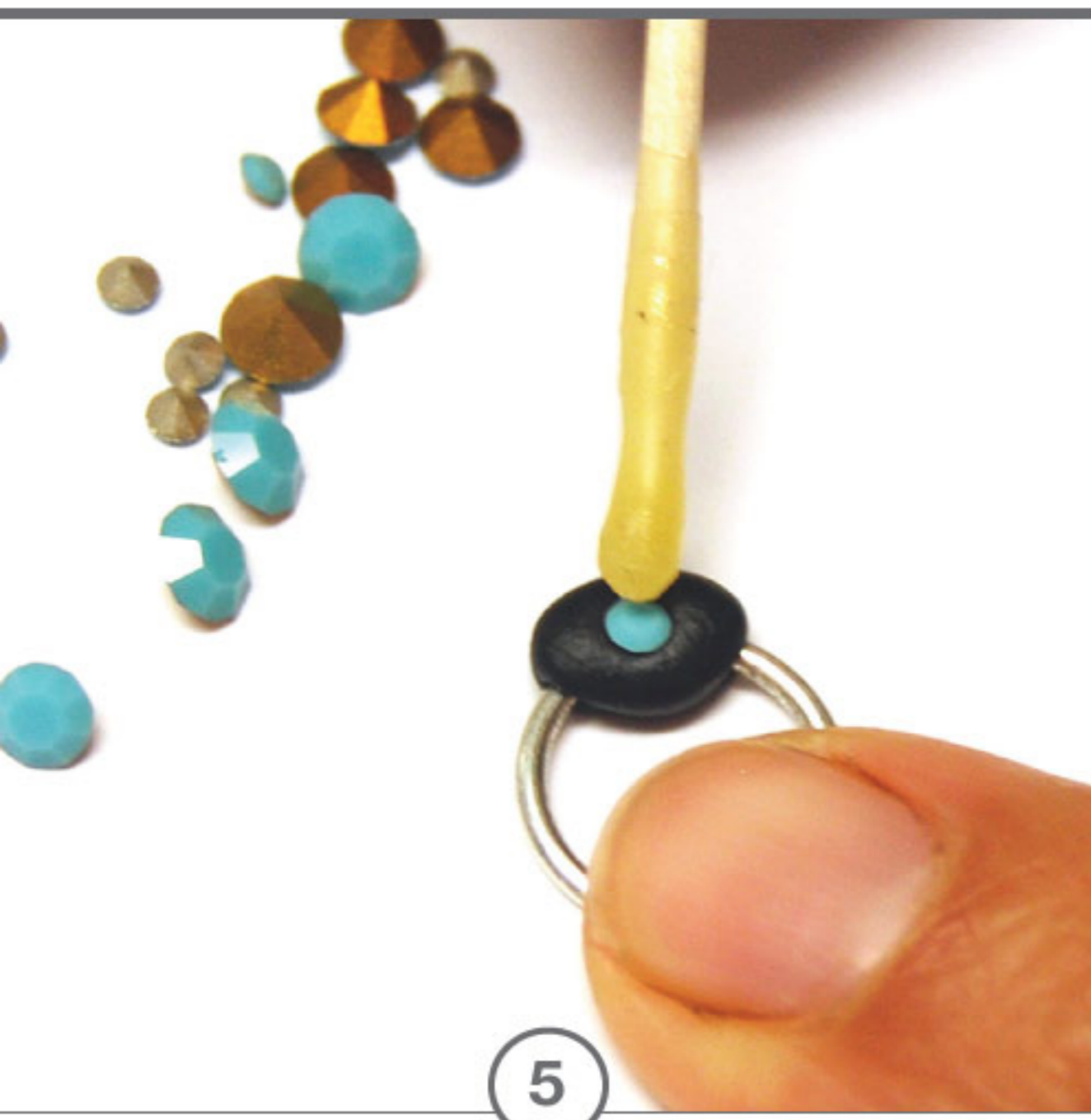

Make sure the jump ring is flushed closed.

Press the clay around the jump ring. Use your fingertips to sculpt the clay creating the look you want.

If you would like to add a chaton, make sure that there is enough clay to fully embed your chaton. Let cure 24 hours.

String all your accent jump rings on a necklace for a great look!
