

MAKE EASY STACKED
BEADCAP EARRINGS



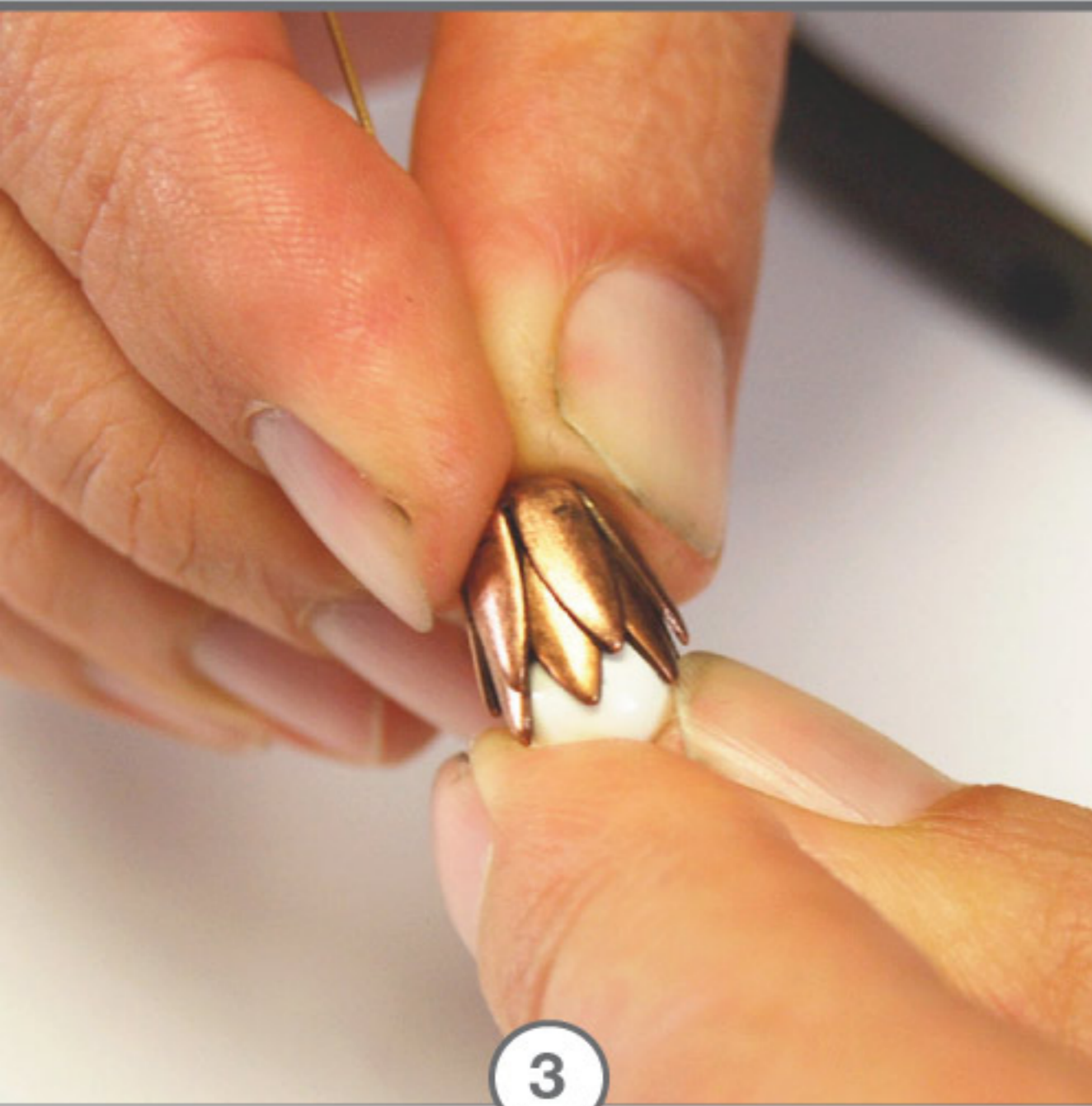

Gather your supplies: eyepins, beadcaps, beads, jumprings, and leverback earwires.



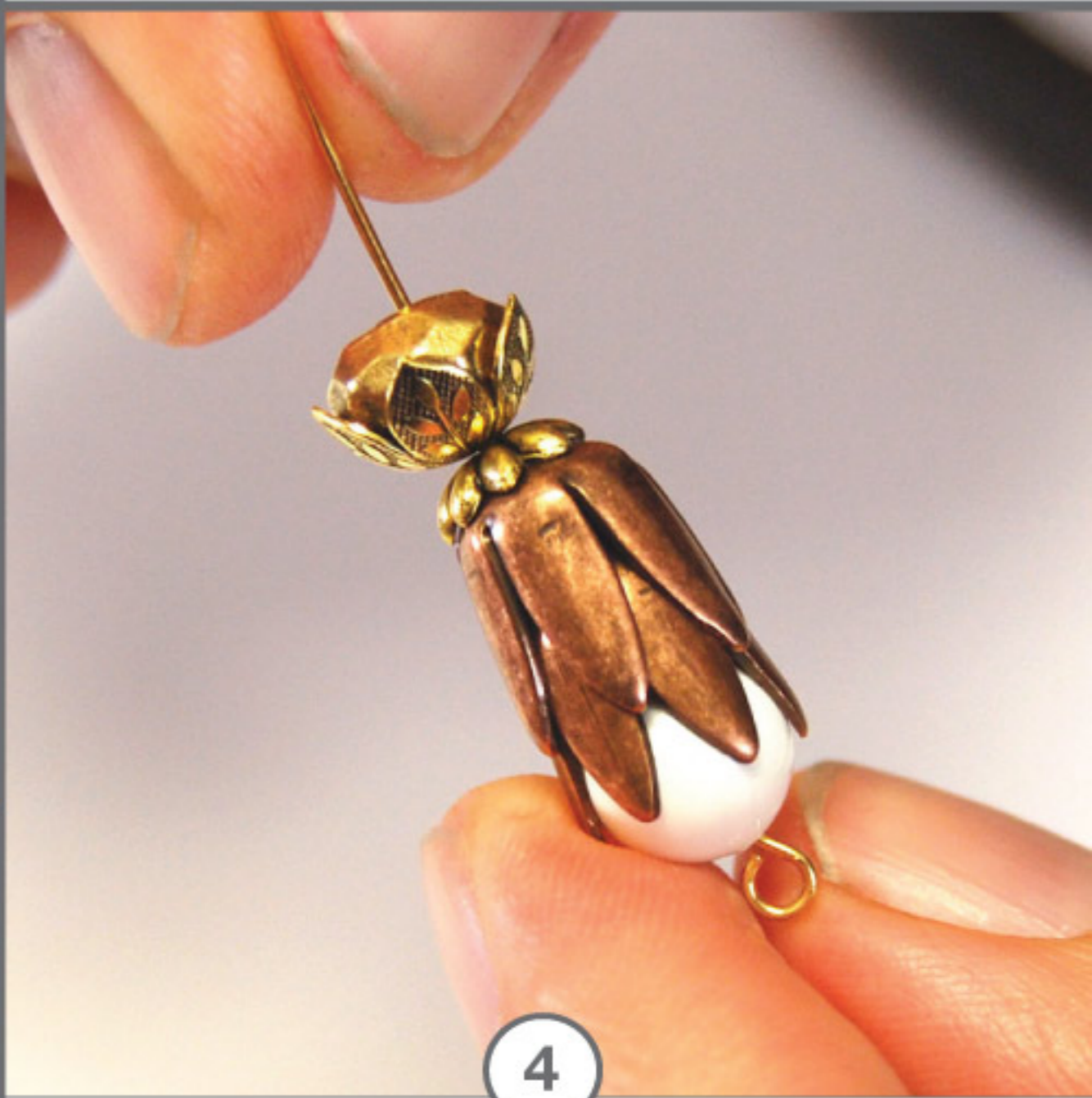

Thread onto Eyepin: 8mm bead and 1 Beadcap 8mm Flower Petal. Press gently on beadcap and petals will slightly bend around bead.

Thread on the second Beadcap 8mm Flower Petal so that petals alternate.



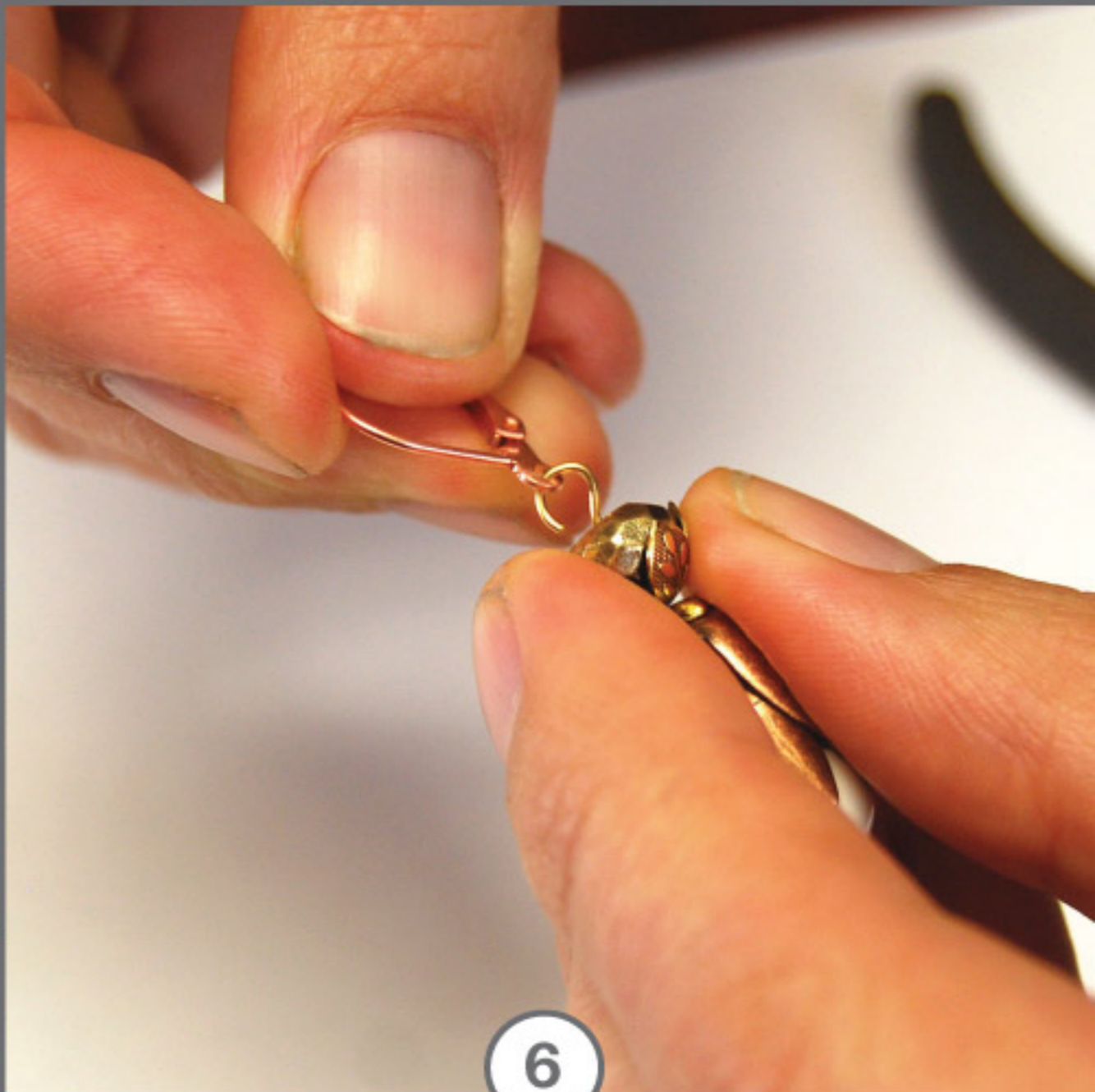

Thread beadcaps onto Eyepin in order; 1 Beadcap 6mm Petal, 1 Beadcap 8mm Etched Daisy upside down, 1 Metal Bead Faceted.

Trim away all but 1/4 inch of the Eyepin using a pair of Flush Cutters.

Create a loop using a pair of flat nose pliers. Before closing the loop, add an Earwire Leverback.



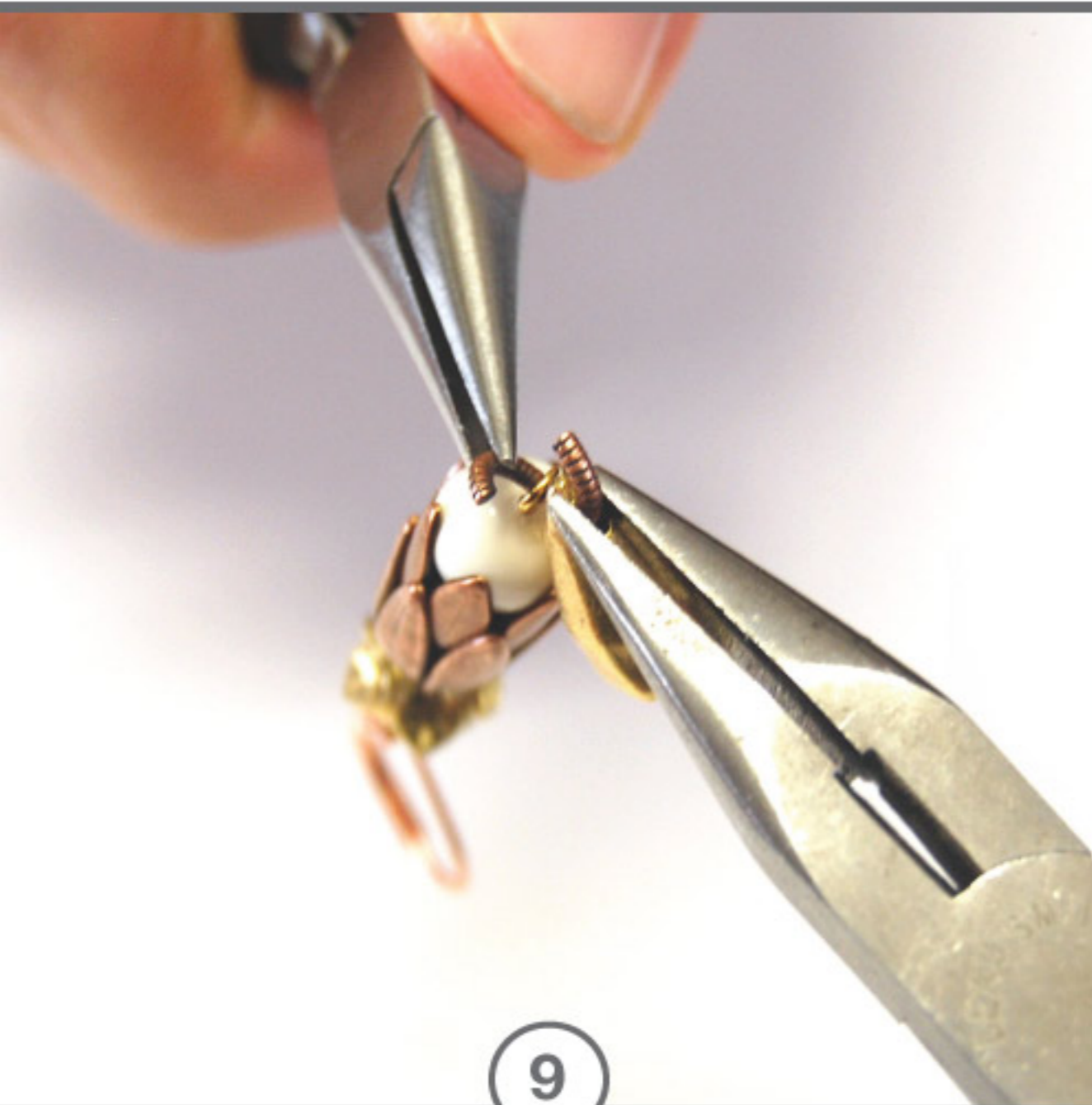

To ensure that the earring hangs correctly, make sure the top loop of the eyepin is at a 90 degree angle from the bottom eyepin loop.

Using 2 pairs needle nose pliers, open Jumpring 6mm Textured Circle, thread on a Metal Bead Faceted Drop...

...and the eye of the assembled Eyepin. Close the jumpring. Now repeat steps for a 2nd earring and wear!
